
We use production quantities for palm oil and coffee per department as weights,





## Step 4: We determine the final national and subnational risk scores for coffee and palm oil through qualitative research.

We conduct a standardised literature study to account for the production systems, cultivation methods and workforce composition of a specific commodity.

The average final risk score for child labour in the **coffee** sector is 4.1. The range of the final risk scores is 3.2-4.9. Based on 20 final risk scores (batch 2023/2024).

The average final risk score for child labour in the **palm oil** sector is 3.9. The range of the final risk scores is 2.8-4.8. Based on 13 final risk scores (batch 2023/2024).

These risk scores are based on the input from the following sources: *Global Data Lab, Unicef, World Bank, complemented by a standardised literature study.*
